





Sewer work not shown on Key Plan:


- Side sewer lateral replacement between Jennings and Ingalls









Another community group has been working on ideas for Jennings Plaza lot that we learned about on Monday 2/8/16.


> Lena Miller, Hunters Point Family, will present concept plans for use of the lot.
